- 1. Read Psalm 50. Discuss the nature of God, what God he is doing and to whom.
 - -v. 1-2 What is the description of God?
 - -v. 3-6 What are God's actions?
- -v. 7-15. Who is God speaking to? What does it mean in v. 8 offerings are continually before me? What's the point of sacrifices always before God? What is that the picture of for us today? (Romans 6:10, 1 Peter 3:18, 2 Cor 5:15-17) What does this mean for God's people, vs 14? (Romans 1:21,12:1-2, Hebrews 10:1-18)
 - -v. 16-21 Who is God speaking to? What is the nature of the character of the people God is referring?
 - -v. 22-23 What is God's judgment and blessing?
- 2. What are the parallels, if any, that you see from this text that are being lived out currently in our society?
- 3. Dale suggested in his sermon that "we the people" have separated from the reality of the laws of nature and nature's God. The reality that our founders believed and understood. Read the following quotes and discuss how they put Scripture into action.

21 Principles of Government from Romans 13 Doug Wilson

Note: When Paul wrote Romans, Nero was yet to lose his mind.

- 1. Civil Government is a blessing and not necessarily evil.
 - -2 Samuel 23:3-4
 - -Must be just to be the blessing of God
 - -The people are to be grateful.
- 2. God established a Righteous Throne with Majesty.
 - -Prov 16:12; Daniel 4:30; 1 Chronicles 25:29
 - -God causes to look upon the ruler in honor because of righteousness.
- 3. The Law of God is the Soul of a Good Ruler
 - -Exodus 18:21
 - -Qualifications for good ruler; Fear God, Truthful, cannot covet.
- 4. God Requires true humility
 - -Deut 17:20
- 5. The People should honor.
 - -1 Peter 2:17
- -When Peter and Paul wrote roughly 50ad, Nero had a sound mind for 5 good years. Therefore, Paul was writing under a stable government.
 - -Revelation 21:24 the Christian church.
 - -This honor is real. Satan temped Jesus with it. I'll give it to you; you don't have to go to the cross.
- -Humanity does do some good things. Babylon tower before God changed their language. That attitude will always bend to sin without the gospel.
- 6. Tyrants love moral corruption but hate virtuous men.
 - -Free love is the first bribe to a slave Chesterton.
- -Revelation 2:14 they love a brain-dead people and unthinking people to control, and fornication is a weapon of war.
- 7. Absolute perfection is not the point in a leader.
 - -Psalm 51:11; not about salvation but about the wisdom to rule.
 - -David forfeited the throne because of his sin.
 - 1 Kings 15:14
- -we are not perfectionists, cynics, anarchists. Our current system the Dems want to go 100 miles an hour the Repubs 10, but both are heading toward destruction.
- 8. Tyranny is a judgement from God for the sins of the people.
 - -1 Samuel 8:11 the ruler with take.

Deut says Israel would get a king but not like the kings of the other nations. God restricted them to not obtain horses, wives and gold.

-God still delivers his people but we have not been jealous over liberty issues. Righteousness establishes a throne, but unrighteousness destabilizes a throne.

- 9. All Civil Authorities are under Gods authority.
 - -Romans 13. They are servants and servants take orders.

Ahab was a bad actor.

10. Civil disobedience is required of Christians where matters of worship and the gospel are concerned.

Daniel 3:18; Acts 5:29

- 11. Civil disobedience in other areas
 - 1 Samuel 24:5; 24:22; 1 Corinthians 11:32-33
- -Peter and Paul were fugitives from the law, like David with Saul yet David honored Saul more than any other, but he didn't turn himself in.
- 12. Civil Government is covenantal.
 - 2 Chronicles 23:16

There is a dual covenant.

- 13. No Human authority is absolute.
 - -Man is limited

Daniel 4:35 everyone has boundaries.

- 14. Not everything legal is lawful.
 - -Revelation 13:17

What is against the law does not define sin or vice versa, God does.

- 15. Faithful Believers will be accused of Rebellion and treason.
 - -Elisha and Ahab 2 Chronicles 20:13
- 16. Bible teaches the consent of the governed.
 - -1 Kings 12:1

Rehoboam was elected. Kings of Israel were elected.

The idea of "divine right" of kings is not biblical.

- 17. a lot of the character of the people and rulers are tied together.
 - -Proverbs 29:12
- 18. Resistance of tyranny is not the same resistance of the civil order.
- -2 Chronicles 23:11 the throne was defended by removing the usurper from the throne. God has a covenant with government. Government has one to its people and with they break it the people have a right to speak up.

19. Lesser magistrates obey the priest

-2 Chronicles 23:1-3

The pretender was removed from the throne.

When the higher ups break the law, act tyrannically, the lessors have the responsibility not to enforce.

Marriage
